

HIGHLIGHTS

- Major supply decision — emphasizing greenhouse gas emissions reductions — outlines our company's plans to meet Saskatchewan's growing electricity needs from 2010-2014.
- SaskPower becomes the first utility in the world to successfully complete a workable design for a large scale near-zero emissions pulverized coal plant.
- Plans are unveiled for the addition of up to 400 megawatts (MW) of simple cycle natural gas turbines, which emit 50% less carbon dioxide (CO₂) than coal generators.
- SaskPower Eneraction portfolio of efficiency, conservation and load management programs is introduced.
- Over 16,000 compact fluorescent light bulbs are distributed for free in six communities.
- New Net Metering Program encourages development of green power by customers.
- Centennial Wind Power Facility completes first full calendar year of operation with a capacity factor rating in the top 10% of wind power facilities in the world.
- First of four new waste heat recovery units completes initial year of operation as part of SaskPower's Environmentally Preferred Power Program.
- SaskPower develops pioneering fish and fish habitat protocol agreement with Fisheries and Oceans Canada, Saskatchewan Ministry of Environment and Saskatchewan Watershed Authority.
- Online Environmental Screening System training continues across SaskPower.
- Emissions Control Research Facility furthers mercury, sulphur dioxide, nitrogen oxides and particulate control research.
- Major unit overhaul at Poplar River Power Station leads to greater generation efficiency.
- Energy Performance Contracting agreement signed with the Sunrise Health Region, with resulting energy efficiency upgrades projected to generate \$473,000 in annual savings.
- Customers reduce greenhouse gas emissions by over 50,000 tonnes during the year by purchasing EcoLogo-certified GreenPower.
- Province-wide Power Savings campaigns educate customers on energy efficiency.
- SaskPower Shand Greenhouse reaches distribution mark of over 5.7 million seedlings since opening.
- Environmental Management System re-registered under the ISO 14001 Standard following annual independent audits.
