**SUBJECT: SUCCESSFUL PROSECUTION OF AN UNLICENSED
SASKATCHEWAN GAS CONTRACTOR**

On September 13, 2006 an unlicensed Weyburn area Contractor pled guilty to:

- a) Five counts of commencing gas work when a permit had not been issued contrary to Section 12 of *The Gas Inspection Act, 1993*.
- b) Three counts of installing equipment or apparatus not in accordance with the *National Gas Installation Code* then applicable contrary to Section 16 *The Gas Inspection Regulations*.
- c) Two counts of connecting a gas installation with a distribution system without a permit contrary to section 13 of *The Gas Inspection Act, 1993*.

The total fine imposed was \$1800.00

SaskPower Gas Inspections will continue to monitor industry for compliance with *The Gas Inspection Act, 1993*, *The Gas Licensing Act*, and the gas codes. Continued support from gas contractors is essential in our on-going effort to maintain high standards of professionalism within the industry and in support of public safety objectives.
