Develops and implements effective work plans and schedules for multiple undertakings that involve different groups. Able to redirect resources quickly to meet changing priorities while managing competing tasks.
Judgement & Decision Making	Makes and supports or alters decisions based on the long-term implications to the customer and the organization. Is capable of developing, modifying or using different decision-making processes to positively impact multiple stakeholders.
Problem Solving & Innovation	Anticipates, identifies, and defines problems from multiple angles to determine causes and effects; uses both analytical and creative thinking to generate potential solutions based on root causes; works collaboratively with others to implement timely solutions; explores and iterates new ideas to inform and validate solutions.
