JOB FAMILY COMPETENCIES	
Analytical Thinking	Identifies multiple links and/or chains of events and recognizes their implications. Investigates to determine obstacles and opportunities. Looks at ideas, analyzes information in a systematic way and draws conclusions from relevant information.
Building Relationships	Develops and nurtures contacts with individuals or groups in different parts of the organization or beyond the organization. Establishes broad-based relationships, networks or groups to facilitate opportunities to discuss and share information.
Communication	Adapts communication strategy and interpersonal approaches to a situation. Perseveres in the face of complex, hard-to-handle situations. Effectively conveys both readily apparent and underlying messages to others.
Delivering Service & Quality	Monitors own work and/or work of others for service and quality by keeping records of alterations, changes and variations from accepted service and quality standards and commitments.
Identifying, Planning & Executing	Initiates activities involving others, organizing work to maximize overall efficiency and effectiveness while ensuring high-quality output. Develops plans to optimize available resources and adjusts decisions as required.
