

SASKPOWER COVID-19 VACCINATION POLICY

Contractor Certification Form

As a Contractor for SaskPower, your review and acknowledgement of the requirements outlined in this document are mandatory prior to working for SaskPower. The items in this acknowledgement are aligned with the Contract; therefore, by executing this form, the Contractor is verifying that they are in compliance with the requirements set out herein. It is the Contractor’s responsibility to communicate these requirements to all on-site Workers and Subcontractors.

This Acknowledgement Form must be executed by a director, officer or other person having the legal authority to contractually bind the Contractor.

SaskPower recognizes that some Contractors may be able to certify their personnel and other staff are fully vaccinated. In these cases, SaskPower will accept a one-time declaration.

I _____, an authorized representative of _____ (the “Company”) providing services to SaskPower, hereby acknowledge and certify that:

1. The Company is aware of SaskPower’s vaccine and testing verification process being implemented effective October 1, 2021.
2. The Company is aware, as a service provider to SaskPower, that in order to continue to provide services at any site or property owned or occupied by SaskPower where the services are being performed, all staff or other personnel of the Company providing such services must be either fully vaccinated or provide proof of a negative COVID-19 prior to accessing the site or property.
3. The Company will ensure that all staff or other personnel that the Company provides in connection with the services it provides to SaskPower have been verified as having been fully vaccinated with the required doses of a Health Canada approved COVID-19 vaccination or have provided proof of a negative COVID-19 prior to entering the site or property, at such intervals as may be required by SaskPower.
4. The Company will furnish such evidence or records as may be reasonably requested by SaskPower from time to time to establish its compliance with this certification.
5. The Company will advise SaskPower immediately should the status of staff or other personnel change.
6. Any employee or other personnel who is not compliant with the SaskPower vaccine and testing certification process may be removed from or denied access to any site or property where services are being performed for or on behalf of SaskPower.
