STANDARD RATE

This rate is for farms with normal household and agricultural use, served through SaskPower – supplied transformation up to and including 3000 kV.A.

MINIMUM BILL

The basic monthly charge plus \$4.869/kVA of the maximum demand over 50 kilovolt ampere (kVA) registered over the past 11 months.

IRRIGATION RATE

This rate is for farm irrigation loads served through SaskPower-supplied transformation for the annual pumping season between April 1 and Oct. 31.

MINIMUM BILL

The basic seasonal charge.

LOADS ABOVE 1,000 KILOVOLT AMPERES (kVA)

For loads in excess of 1,000 kVA, a different rate structure will apply. Please see SaskPower Supplied Transformation — Standard Rates, Customer-Owned Transformation — Standard Rates or Customer-Owned Transformation — Power Standard Rates.

IRRIGATION (INTERRUPTIBLE) RATE

This rate is for farm irrigation main pumping stations requiring in excess of 1,000 kilovolt amperes (kVA) served on an interruptible basis through customer-owned transformation, and for related booster pumps and pivot systems less than 1,000 kVA that will be inoperable as a consequence of an interruption to the main pumping station. The annual irrigation pumping season is from April 1 to Oct. 31.
